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Session Description



- To implement Guided Pathways effectively, it's important to have broad engagement across all campus groups and for everyone, regardless of their role on campus, to understand how they can best support the success of students in getting and staying on the path.
- To that end, professional development is a critical tool to foster engagement and to move Guided Pathways forward. In this session, you will hear about a variety of ideas for building a campus structure for professional development related to Guided Pathways. And, of course, there will be discussion of how to deal with challenges (e.g., money, time, follow-up).



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Why is PD Important?

- Greatest asset of an educational institution is the people who work there
- Institutions need to invest in their own staff to be successful
- Best ideas will always fail unless staff understand their role and are trained to perform the expected role



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Why is PD Important?

- Change is hard for most
- Moving to Guided Pathways is a different way than most have traditionally thought about education
- PD helps staff understand the rationale for Guided Pathways and engages them in the process

- Industry Certifications
 - Considerations of each (expertise, preparation, costs, scheduling, follow-up) for what you are trying to achieve

Career Development Facilitator (CDF) Training



- 120 hour train-the-trainer model for advisors
- CDF training introduced an ecosystem that fostered a learning community among staff, faculty, and employers, cultivating internship and employment opportunities alike
- Advisors are equipped with the knowledge and confidence to identify students' career needs and ask students the right questions to assist them with career guidance
- Integrated career exploration into advising sessions

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


Leadership Models














Leadership Models





Triad Leadership Model






